



IME BECAS / HACEMOS Scholarship FAQ's

1. **Where can I apply for 2024 IME Becas HACEMOS Scholarship (North Texas)?** It's very easy. Just click on the [link](https://hacemosimebecas-dfw.org/), copy-paste onto your browser <https://hacemosimebecas-dfw.org/> or scan QR code below. See requirements and apply. It's that simple!



2. **What is an official transcript?** This document validates your Junior High, High School or College courses taken, grades earned and cumulative grade point average (GPA). **Make sure it is an OFFICIAL transcript copy.** Official transcripts must have either signature or school seal. Unofficial transcripts will not be accepted.

3. **Can I submit a picture of my transcript?** A copy of the official transcript or picture may be submitted with your application. We prefer that you provide a document in a PDF format when you apply online. Some schools may require sending document directly to our organization, HACEMOS must receive official transcript before application deadline.

4. **If I'm currently in college, can I apply for the HACEMOS Scholarship if I obtained this scholarship in previous years?** Yes, you can apply. HACEMOS scholarship is not renewable, and you need to reapply. We encourage you to reapply every year to be able to support your studies.

5. **Can I apply for HACEMOS scholarship if I attend a Community College?** Yes. If you meet scholarship requirements, (see question 1) we encourage you to submit your application the number of years you continue your studies at a Community College.

6. **Which documents do I need as proof of Mexican Nationality or descendency from another Latin American Country?** These include foreign Passport, birth certificate or matricula consular. If you don't have any of these documents, please reach out to the closest and respective consulate to file and obtain any of the documents previously referenced.

7. **I am not of Mexican descent; can I still apply?** Yes. IME Becas HACEMOS Scholarship accepts all applications submitted by Hispanic students (all Latin-American counties).

8. **Do I need recommendation letters?** Yes. Letters of recommendation are necessary to better know your academic and personal character from someone else's perspective. We would appreciate receiving recommendation letters from your teachers or employers (if applicable) to learn more about you. Please avoid submitting recommendation letters from direct family members. Request your recommendation letter from your professor ahead of time, your teacher may opt sending letters directly to HACEMOS mailbox before application deadline.
